



Re-certification Guideline for Green Healthcare Facilities Rating System

1. Introduction

IGBC has introduced 'Re-certification for Green Healthcare Facilities' which are rated under IGBC Green Healthcare Facilities rating system, with intent to sustain & enhance the building performance in all aspects.

The adoption and implementation of re-certification process has been simplified. The project has to address few mandatory requirements and credits for this process as follows:

- The project has to meet the green requirements and submit documentation to IGBC as mentioned in the enclosed *Annexure-1*.
- For re-certification, the project shall submit the documentation only once for IGBC review and rating.
- The final certification review will be released in 30 working days from the date of submission.

2. Benefits of Recertification:

- Conform to the latest building Standards and Codes (Energy, Water and IEQ)
- Maintain & improve building performance on continuous basis. Participate in IGBC's "Performance Challenge for Green Built Environment"
- Reduction in operation costs (energy and water)
- Green Benchmarking and identify opportunities for improving energy and water performance.

3. Re-certification Fee:

For re-certification, the project is not required to pay any registration fee. The registration number assigned to the project earlier will hold good.

The applicable Re-certification fee for the project would be 50% of the standard certification fee for a project of equivalent built up area applying for certification for the first time. The standard IGBC certification fee for Green Healthcare Facilities is enclosed. Please refer *Annexure-2*

4. Payment Pattern:

The project shall pay 100% Re-certification fee along with the submission of documents for re-certification. Payments to be made through DD/ Cheque in favour of "Confederation of Indian Industry", payable at Hyderabad.

Annexure-1: Recertification Document Requirement

- 1. In case of expansion/ any new addition to existing facility, the project has to show the compliance for all Mandatory Requirements and Credits for New Healthcare Facility as per IGBCGreen Healthcare Facilities Rating System (Version 1).
- 2. In case of any retrofitting/ renovation in the existing Healthcare Facility, the project has to submit the supporting documents for following:

WC Credit 2: Water Efficient Plumbing Fixtures

BMR MR 1: Handling of Waste Materials, During Construction

BMR Credit 1: Sustainable Building Materials
